

# CAMDEN NEWS NOTES

\*\* County Collector Sell has notified the several township and borough governments that have failed to pay their proportionate share towards the building of stone roads that unless the same is paid within ten days suit will be brought to recover the money.

\*\* The funerals of Albert Anderson, of Rosedale, Atlantic county, and Michael Kelle of 410 Taylor avenue, Camden, who were killed by the falling of a steel girder Wednesday, took place yesterday. The body of the former was interred in Calvary Cemetery, Philadelphia, and the latter in Evergreen Cemetery, of Camden.

\*\* Miss Jeannette Dempster, of 532 North Sixth street, struck a needle in her finger a month ago. The wound apparently healed. Yesterday her hand swelled to twice its normal size, and she was compelled to call in a physician.

\*\* Daniel Weldon, of 1223 South Third street, who shot his wife Mary and tried to kill himself some months ago, while brooding over the murder of his daughter, has been taken to the county insane asylum. After shooting his wife he hovered between life and death for two months. County Physician Jones and Dr. Litchfield adjudged him insane.

\*\* Sarah Quirk, aged 65 years, of Taylor avenue and Park place, slipped on an icy pavement yesterday and dislocated her knee.

\*\* Harry Halsey and wife, of Sixth street and Balmain avenue, were committed to the county jail by Recorder Stackhouse yesterday on the charge of keeping a disorderly house. Three others found in the place were held in \$500 bail as witnesses. The raid was made by Captain Stanley and squad.

\*\* The police were notified yesterday that the gas slot meter in former Mayor Joseph E. Nowrey's office and the telephone box of a garage adjoining had been broken open and robbed.
