

NONE OF STOLEN MONEY FOUND ON SUSPECT

Oscar Lawhead was brought back from Buffalo to Camden yesterday by County Detective Cherry to answer a charge of stealing \$120 from Mrs. Frank Grundy, of 20 Market street. When he returned Lawhead did not have a cent.

He was employed by the woman's husband as a plasterer and asked Grundy for the loan of \$3. Grundy told Lawhead to go upstairs and he would find the money beneath the carpet. Unknown to Grundy, his wife had also used the carpet as an improvised bank. Mrs. Grundy's hoard, which was \$120, the plasterer is alleged to have purloined.

Going to Harrisburg he fell in with some "good fellows." Shortly after Lawhead found himself speeding away on a train. He had been drugged and robbed of \$80. After that he went to Buffalo, where the balance of his money disappeared. Here he was taken into custody and held pending requisition papers.
