

DEATHS IN THE HOME OF MURDERERS' GUARD

Son and Mother-in-Law of Con-
stable Charles Peters Expired in
Camden Within a Week

Death has visited the home of Con-
stable Charles H. Peters, 816 Chestnut
street, Camden, twice within the present
week. On Sunday his son, Harry Peters,
died from the effects of exposure result-
ing from his experience while a soldier
in the Philippines. Yesterday Mrs. Mary
Sage, a nonagenarian and the mother-in-
law of Constable Peters, passed away.
While she had been ailing, her death
was hastened by that of her grandson,
of whom she was very fond.

A peculiar feature in connection with
the deaths is that Constable Peters is
one of the death watches assigned by
Sheriff Somers to look after Charles Gib-
son and Stephen Dorsey, the negroes who
are awaiting electrocution for the murder
of Mrs. Frances Horner.
